Objective of the meeting of the Transatlantic Advisory Board (TAB) in the Transatlantic Project:

The core objective of the transatlantic advisory board is to build up the exchanges between the regions within the Atlantic Ocean and their respective stakeholders, active in the BLUE ECONOMY. This meeting of the TAB focuses on the policy framework, in which the opportunities to strengthen the transnational cooperation related to different sectors of the blue economy (research, sustainable economic development, ports and maritime industry) can be enrooted. Moreover, it aims to valorise the results of the first mission to the province of Québec and to feed the contents of the next mission to the region of Wales (May 2025). In a larger context, it will help to identify the potential to develop a more structured cooperation within the Atlantic Area, involving and attracting non-EU stakeholders.
