Objective of the Webinars in Transatlantic Project:

The core objective of the webinar is to build up the exchanges between the regions within the Atlantic Ocean and their respective stakeholders, active in the BLUE ECONOMY. This webinar identifies the opportunities to strengthen the transnational cooperation on different levels: policy, research, sustainable economic development, ports and maritime industry, all within the sphere of blue economy. Moreover, it aims to feed the contents of the second mission that is planned within the scope of the TRANSATLANTIC project: this mission visits the region of Wales (Q2 2025). In a larger context, it will help to identify the potential to develop a more structured cooperation with non-EU stakeholders. In order to realise this target, it is important to get a better understanding of the different tools that are actually available.

Major attention hereby goes to: green corridors and the decarbonization of ports, the development of sustainable aquaculture and marine renewable energy. Within each of these sectors, the role of artificial intelligence is of major importance.
